CONSTRUCTION OF A WASHINGTON COUNTY JAIL
 IT IS PROPOSED TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A JAIL FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS, ON LAND TO BE PURCHASED ONE BLOCK NORTH OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY COURTHOUSE, ON COLLEGE AVENUE IN FAYETTEVILLE, ARKANSAS. THE COST OF THE PROJECT IS ESTIMATED TO BE \$2,700,000.  IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE BALANCE OF THE COSTS OF THE PROJECT WILL BE FINANCED BY THE JAIL BOARD ISSUING REVENUE BONDS UNDER ACT NO. 879 OF 1981, AS AMENDED, IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$2,000,000. THE BONDS, PLUS INTEREST AND SERVICING FEES, WILL BE SPECIAL OBLIGATIONS OF THE JAIL BOARD SECURED SOLELY BY JAIL FEES LEVIED UNDER ACT 879. IN ADDITION TO BOND PAYMENTS MADE WITH JAIL FEES, THE WASHINGTON COUNTY QUORUM COURT MAY APPROPRIATE MONEYS FROM TIME TO TIME FROM GENERAL FUNDS OF THE COUNTY FOR THE JAIL BOARD TO MAKE BOND PAYMENTS WHEN DUE.
