SCHOOL BOND ELECTION
LANCASTER COUNTY SCHOOL
DISTRICT 001
(LINCOLN PUBLIC SCHOOLS)

"Shall Lancaster County School District 001 (more commonly referred to as the Lincoln Public Schools) issue its negotiable general obligation bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$17,000,000.00 for the purpose of paying for the construction, furnishing, and equipping of new school buildings and new additions to presently existing school buildings and for the renovation, remodeling, refurbishing, and re-equipping of existing school buildings, said bonds to be dated at the time of their issuance, to become due and payable on such dates as may be fixed by the Board of Education of the District at the time of their issuance, to be redeemable as provided for by law, and to bear interest from date of issuance at such rate or rates as shall be determined by the Board; and Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as such principal and interest become due and payable?"
