INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS: To vote for a candidate of your selection, punch the ballot card in the hole next to the right of the name of that candidate. Where two or more candidates for the same office are to be elected, punch the ballot card in the hole next to the right of the names of all candidates for that office for whom you desire to vote, not to exceed, however, the number of candidates who are to be elected. To vote for a person not on the ballot, write the title of office and his name in the blank space left for that purpose on the write-in ballot envelope.

If you wrongly stamp, tear or deface the ballot, return it to the election clerk and obtain another.
