

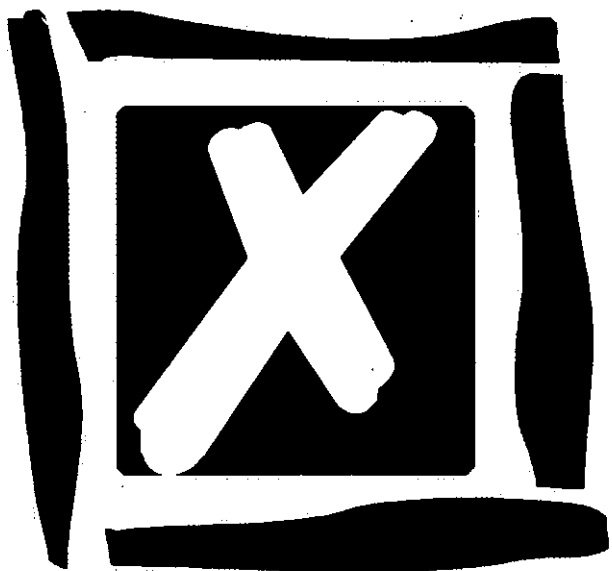
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**Register
to vote**



Must Be 18 Years or Older

In order for you to be registered as a voter, you must be 18 years or older.

Who Qualifies for Registration

You must be

1. A British Subject;
2. Deemed to belong to the Virgin Islands* and
3. Domiciled and resident in the Virgin Islands* or
4. Domiciled in the Virgin Islands and resident in the USVI.

Application Forms

Application Forms can be collected from all Post Offices in the British Virgin Islands and Government Offices in Anegada, Virgin Gorda and Jost Van Dyke. Also at the Office of the Supervisor of Elections, Old Administration Building, upstairs the Post Office, Road Town, Tortola.

Presenting an Application

An application must be signed by a competent witness and should be accompanied with proof of status (i.e. Birth Certificate, Naturalization, Belongers Card).

Completed Forms

The completed forms with proof of status should be carried or sent to the Elections Office promptly.

Office Hours

Office hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Voters List

After the Legislative Council has been dissolved (no later than Dec. 6) a preliminary voters list must be published within fourteen (14) days after dissolution of council. If you are not on this list, it will be too late to register.
