## **Registration Requirements . . .**

1. You must be a legal resident of Florida and Broward County.
2. You must be eighteen years of age.
3. You must be a citizen of the United States.

You may obtain forms for absentee registration and voting from my office if you are:

- Members of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marine and their families.
- Citizens of the United States who are permanent residents of Broward County who are temporarily out of the County, State or Country.
- Residents who are physically disabled and unable to get to registration offices.

## **Important Voter Information . . .**

### **Carry your registration card.**

You must have your card with you as identification on election day in order to vote. Your polling place address is on this card, as well as the Congressional, State House and Senate districts in which you reside.

### **How to change parties or replace a lost card.**

To change your party affiliation or replace a lost card, you may either come into one of our offices or make your request in writing.

### **When to register.**

You may register up to 30 days before an election. Registration books will then be closed until after the election. Any registrations made during that 30-day period will be held for processing until after the election.

The registration offices provide special late hours and Saturdays just before the registration books are closed, to enable the greatest number of voters to register. Traveling registration units visit various parts of the county at frequent intervals preceding elections. Please call us if you have suggestions for areas that should be visited.
