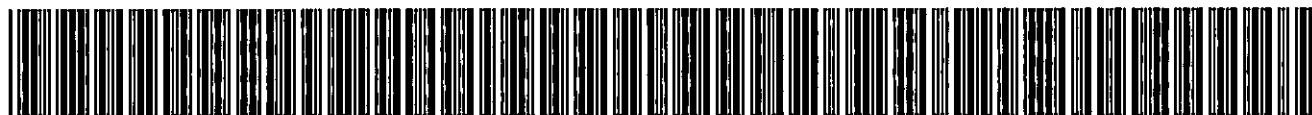

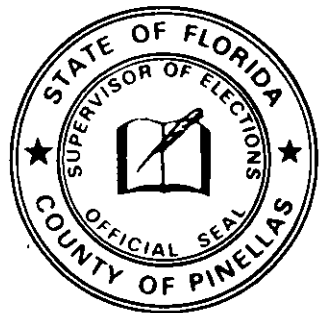

IMPORTANT VOTING INFORMATION

You must vote in the precinct where you legally reside. If you cannot get to your polling place or if you are going to be out of the county on election day, either come into one of our Election Offices and vote absentee, or call **462-4590 NOW** to have an absentee ballot sent to you.

Remind your family and friends to vote. This sample ballot may be taken to the polls for reference.

Budget restrictions prevent us from mailing more than one sample ballot to each household regardless of how many voters reside there. Additional copies may be picked up at any of our offices as long as the supply lasts.

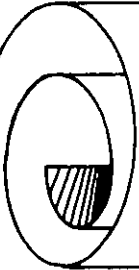

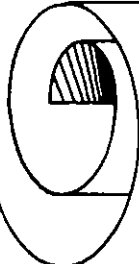
Pinellas County is divided into 316 precincts and has 20 different ballot styles representing the U.S. Congress, State Senate and House of Representatives, School Board, and the Board of County Commissioners. There are also 24 municipalities within Pinellas County.

Your precinct number and district numbers are designated on your Voter Identification Card. If you have lost your ID card, write and request a new one. However, if you are eligible to vote and you do not have your voter ID card, you may take other identification (a driver's license, for example) to your polling place on election day.
