These changes do not affect who your Congressperson, State Senator, or State Representative is during 1992. However, when you go to the polls in 1992, the new boundaries will determine for whom you vote. None of these changes affects your ward and division.

Important Election Dates in 1992

First day to circulate and file nomination papers nominating independent candidates.

Last day to REGISTER before Primary. All mail applications for registration must be received by your county registration office by this date. Also, last day to **change** party or non-partisan enrollment before the Primary.

Last day before the Primary to apply for civilian absentee ballots other than by "Emergency Application." (NOTE: Regular applications must be *received* by the county board by this date.)

Absentee ballots must be received by the county board of elections by 5:00 PM today to be counted.

These dates will be set once the General Assembly reapportions PA's Congressional Districts.

Registration And Voting Information

To Vote On Election Day, You Must Meet Two Requirements:

You must be an eligible citizen.
You must register as a voter.

1. You Are Eligible To Vote If:

You are a United States citizen,
AND you will be 18 years old by the day after election day (you do not have to be 18 when you register),

AND you will be a resident of your "election district" (that is, your division or precinct) for at least 30 days before election day.

2. You May Register:

—**IN PERSON** at your county registration office (in Philadelphia on the fifth floor of Riverview Place at Delaware Ave. & Spring Garden St., or in Room 138 City Hall; in the suburban counties at the county courthouse).

—**BY MAIL.** You can obtain a mail application form from your county registration office or at your neighborhood post office, library or state liquor store. After you complete it and put it in the mail (postage-free), you will be notified by your county registration office when you are officially registered.

3. You Should Re-Register If:

—you have moved,
OR you have changed your name, through marriage or for any other reason,

OR you have failed to vote in each of the last five regularly scheduled elections,

OR you encountered a mixup in

your registration records at the last election and needed a court order to vote. (Remember: a court order is not effective in subsequent elections.)

4. You May Change Your Party:

—You may change your registration to any party designation. (Remember: in a primary you can only vote for candidates in your party.) You may also change your registration to non-partisan, but you will not be able to vote for candidates in a primary.

—You may do so in person or by mail (*see part 2*).

5. You Can Vote:

—**IN PERSON** at the neighborhood polling place for your election district. To find out your district and polling place, call your county board of elections (and in Philadelphia, the Committee of Seventy). The locations of all local polling places are also printed in the major newspapers for your area shortly before election day.

—**By ABSENTEE BALLOT** if you will be absent from your county of residence because of occupation, business, or duties; or, if you are unable to go to the polls because of illness or disability. Absentee ballots may be obtained from your county board of elections (in Philadelphia in Room 138 City Hall).

6. You May Have Assistance In Voting:

—**ONLY IF** you have indicated your need for assistance on your registration affidavit.

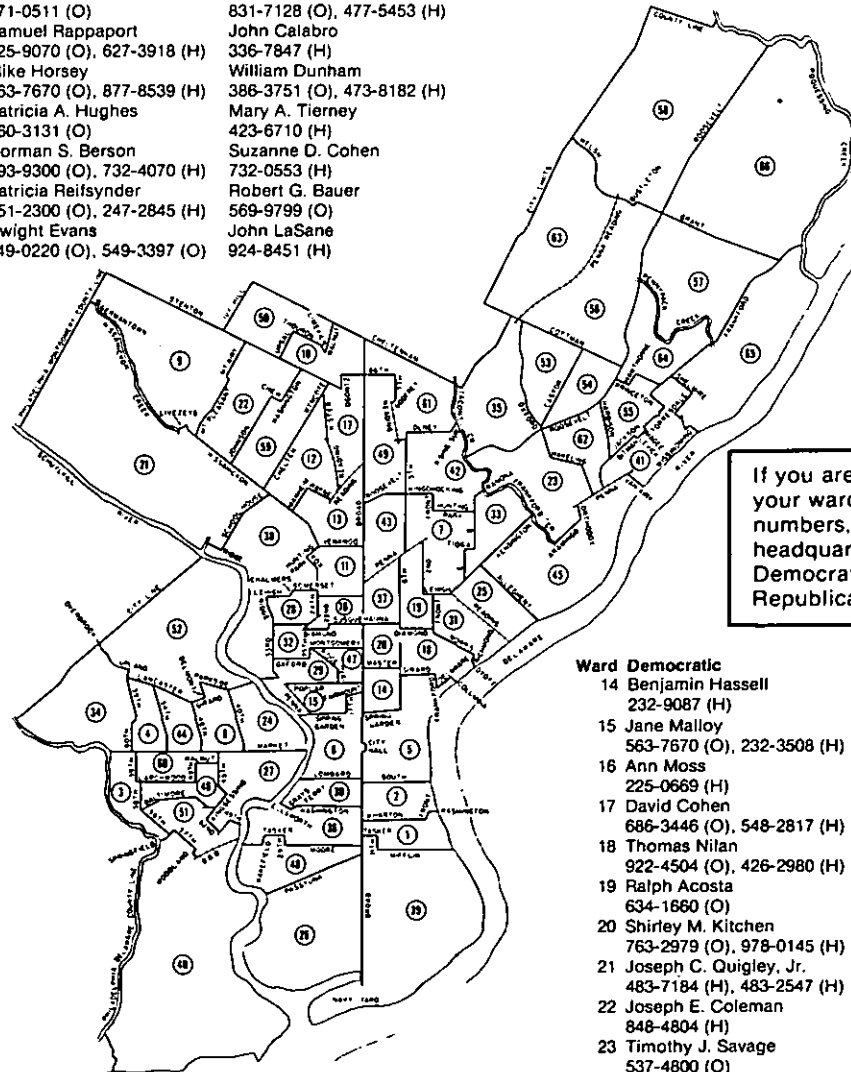
