QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTING

- Citizen of the United States
- Resident of Harris County
- 18 years of age
- AND YOU MUST HAVE REGISTERED TO VOTE IN HARRIS COUNTY. (Voter registration must be submitted at least 30 days prior to an election.)

FACTS ON VOTER REGISTRATION

Voter Registration is handled by the Harris County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office. Voter registration applications may be obtained and all other aspects of voter registration may be handled in one of the following ways:

VOTER REGISTRATION IS PERMANENT. Every two(2) years a new registration certificate will be mailed to you. However, you must notify the **HARRIS COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR'S OFFICE** of any change of name or address. **ALL CORRECTIONS MUST BE COMPLETED THIRTY(30) DAYS PRIOR TO AN ELECTION.** (You may vote in your old Harris County Precinct the first 90 days after moving, provided that the ballots in the old and the new precincts are the same.

If you have **LOST YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE**, do not re-register. You may obtain a replacement certificate from the Harris County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office, 224-1919 - Ext. 310.

If YOU WILL BE 18 YEARS OF AGE on or before an election date, you may register 60 days prior to your birthday. You MUST register 30 days prior to the election.

VOTING

Each voter must vote in the PRECINCT OF RESIDENCE designated on your Voter Registration Certificate. (Precinct lists giving polling locations are printed in the newspapers immediately before an election.)

A STUDENT may register and vote in the county in which she or he declares permanent residence.

ABSENTEE VOTING begins no earlier than twenty(20) days before the election and ends four(4) days before the election. If a qualified voter will be absent from the county on election day, that voter may vote absentee in person during the absentee voting period. If a qualified voter will be absent from the county on election day and also during the absentee voting period, that voter may vote absentee by mail.

Registered voters 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OVER may vote absentee in person or by mail.

Registered voters who because of sickness or physical disability are unable to vote in their precinct on election day may vote absentee by mail or in person during the absentee voting period.

BEFORE ABSENTEE VOTING BEGINS for an election, call the government unit holding the election for the exact procedure and location as they may vary.
