POLLS ARE OPEN FROM 6 A.M. TO 7 P.M. FOR ALL ELECTIONS

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election
- · A resident of Virginia

Voter Registration

WHERE:

Statewide registration is in effect. You may register at any registration site in the state. Local sites include:

Additional sites and hours are scheduled during the period preceding closing of the books prior to election. Call the registrar's office for further information.

A homebound citizen may request a registrar to register him/her at home. Members of the armed forces, citizens temporarily residing outside of the United States and families accompanying such persons may register by mail. Upon proper request and under appropriate circumstances, registrars will attend group meetings in

Fairfax County to register eligible citizens.

WHEN:

You may register year-round except during the 28 days prior to a general or primary election or the 13 days prior to a special election. Registration is permanent unless you move or fail to vote at least once in four consecutive years.

IF YOU

If you move within your city or county, you must notify

MOVE: the Registrar in writing.

If you move between jurisdictions within Virginia, you must transfer your registration either in person or by completing a transfer form available at all registration offices.

Absentee Voting

Any registered voter who expects to be away or otherwise physically unable to go to the polls on election day may request an absentee ballot.

BY MAIL: Application forms may be requested from the General

Registrar's Office beginning ten months before the general election and are also available at registration sites and government centers. Mail applications must be received by the General Registrar at least FIVE DAYS before an election. Voted ballots must be received in the office by

Election Day to be counted.

IN PERSON:

Registered voters may apply for and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Registrar's Office beginning 45 days before an election. In Fairfax County, satellite locations are available before general elections. In-person absentee votes may be cast through the Saturday before each election day.





You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- · A citizen of the United States
- · At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election
- · A resident of Virginia

Additional sites and hours are scheduled during the period preceding closing of the books prior to election. Call the registrar's office for further information.

A homebound citizen may request a registrar to register him/her at home. Members of the armed forces, citizens temporarily residing outside of the United States by virtue of employment and families of such persons may register by mail. Upon proper request and under appropriate circumstances, registrars will attend group meetings in Fairfax County to register eligible citizens.

WHEN:

You may register year-round except during the 30 days prior to a general or primary election or the 13 days prior to a special election. Registration is permanent unless you move or fail to vote at least once in four consecutive years.

IF YOU MOVE: If you move within your city or county, you must notify the Registrar in writing. You may use the back of your voter information card or a change of address card which is available in all libraries. If you move from one county or city to another within Virginia, you must transfer your registration either in person at the Regis-

trar's Office, or by mail through contacting the registrar in either your present or former jurisdiction.

Absentee Voting

BY MAIL:

Any registered voter who is physically unable to go to the polls in person on election day may be eligible to vote an absentee ballot by mail. Application forms may be requested from the General Registrar's Office and are also available at registration sites and government centers. Incomplete applications WILL BE returned for completion, delaying receipt of a ballot. Mail applications must be received by the General Registrar at least FIVE DAYS before an election.

Voted ballots must be received in the office by Election Day to be counted.

IN PERSON: Any registered voter who expects to be away or in the hospital on election day may apply for and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Registrar's Office beginning 45 days before an election. (In Fairfax County, satellite locations are available before general elections.) In-person absentee votes may be cast through the Saturday before each election day.
