how to V ABSENTEE VOTE



THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CONCERNS ABSENTEE VOTING

ABSENTEE VOTERS MUST BE REGISTERED

Any qualified voter who expects to be absent from the county ON ELECTION DAY may vote an ABSENTEE BALLOT. Certain voters may vote either by mail or in person. All others must make an application for a ballot IN PERSON.

IN PERSON ONLY

Any person who will be away on Election Day, but still in the county on or after September 24, must VOTE IN PERSON at the Office of the General Registrar before 5 p.m. on October 31 or at a Satellite Office listed.

Any person who will be absent during the ENTIRE PERIOD of September 24 through October 31 AND ON ELECTION DAY may APPLY IN PERSON any time in the calendar year to have a ballot mailed to the voter's out-of-town address and may VOTE BY MAIL.

BY MAIL OR IN PERSON

- . Member of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marine, or spouse or dependent of a member.
- . Person regularly employed outside the continental United States, or spouse or dependent residing with such a person.
- . Student attending school, or spouse of a student.
- . Person unable to go to the Polls because of physical disability or illness.
- . Person confined while awaiting trial or due to conviction of a misdemeanor.

DEADLINES

MAIL - Mail applications for absentee ballots cannot be accepted at the Registrar's Office later than October 29.

Persons eligible to request a ballot by mail should apply early to avoid mail delays.



Only ballots that are received by the Electoral Board on or before Election Day can be counted.

IN PERSON - Applications made in person must be done before 5 p.m., October 31.

FORMS FOR APPLICATION

Applications forms with printed instructions may be obtained from Office of The General Registrar and other registration locations. They will be mailed to voters on request. Federal Postcard Application (Standard Form 76) is acceptable only from members of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marine, persons regularly employed outside the country and spouses and dependents of such persons. This form is available at all military installations, U.S. Embassies and Consulates in foreign countries.

HANDICAPPED

Curbside voting may be requested at Satellite Office or Central Office. The University Drive location has an ELEVATOR from the ground floor parking area.

State law requires that absentee ballots be voted in the presence of a witness.

On Election Day...Polls open 6 a.m. - close 7 p.m.

NOTE: Registered voters are purged for failure to vote at least one time in four years.
