#### PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

#### **QUESTION 1**

Shall the Constitution of Virginia be amended to provide that the funds in the governmental employees retirement system shall be trust funds and be invested and administered solely in the interests of the members and beneficiaries of the system?



#### **QUESTION 2**

Shall the Constitution of Virginia be amended to provide that the victims of crime shall be treated with fairness, dignity, and respect in the criminal justice process and that the General Assembly may define, by law, the rights of victims of crime?





#### VOTE YES ON ALL FOUR BOND ISSUES.

Democrats endorse bonds for schools, parks, metrorail, and neighborhood improvements.

The Democratic Committee voted to support Questions 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the constitutional amendments. They did not take a stand on number 5.

#### IMPORTANT TIPS FOR VOTING ON NOVEMBER 5:

If possible, vote during off-peak hours. Voter turnout in a presidential year is always heavy. Morning and evening rush hours usually mean long lines. Give yourself plenty of time to vote, and check with your employer regarding liberal leave policy for voting.

Read your sample ballot before coming to the polls. Don't wait until you reach the voting booth to consider your choices on several important issues. It will take the careful reader at least five minutes to simply read through the ballot because you will be voting for President, Vice President, U.S. Senate, Congress, Arlington County Board, and Arlington School Board; and also for five proposed constitutional amendments and four proposed Arlington bond issues.

If you registered to vote this year by the *motor voter* law, be sure to bring your driver's license with you. You will have to either show identification or sign a sworn statement that you are who you say you are.
