ONLY TWO WEEKS LEFT FOR D.C. VOTERS TO REQUEST ABSENTEE BALLOTS BY MAIL

Registered D.C. voters have only two weeks to file a mail request for an absentee ballot for the November 8th Presidential Election, announced Executive Director Emmett H. Fremaux, Jr. today. In the District, absentee voting is available for voters who cannot cast a ballot at the polls because of age, disability, or travel.

To receive an absentee ballot through the mail, a voter must send a written request to the Board of Elections at 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue NW. This request must reach the agency by November 1st and must include the following information: voter's name, residence address, mailing address (if different), reason for voting absentee, and the voter's signature. Any written statement providing the required information will be accepted; however, the application form below (which may be clipped and mailed to the Board in a stamped envelope) is provided for convenience. The form may be reprinted or copied for the purpose of requesting a ballot.
