## ABSENTEE VOTING OPENS FOR NOVEMBER PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

Registered D.C. voters who will be unable to cast a ballot at the polls on Election Day Tuesday, November 8th--because of age, disability, or travel, may vote by absentee ballot, announced Elections Board Director Emmett H. Fremaux, Jr. today.

"Absentee voting activity is always at a peak in presidential elections," Fremaux noted. "We expect to receive thousands of additional requests for absentee ballots by the deadline, and we encourage voters to make arrangements early to avoid the last minute rush."

To cast an absentee ballot by mail, a registered voter must send a written request that includes the following information: voter's name, residence address, mailing address (if different), reason for voting absentee, and the voter's signature. This request must <u>reach</u> the Board of Elections by November 1st. Any written statement that provides the required information will be accepted; however, the application form below (which may be clipped and mailed to the Board in a stamped envelope) is provided for convenience. The form may be reprinted or copied for the purpose of requesting a ballot.
