PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Elections and Ethics at a meeting on Tuesday, July 30, 1996, pursuant to D.C. Code, §1-1320 (p)(1), certified the sufficiency of the initiative petition for the following measure, and further certified that the mitiative will appear on the November 5, 1996 General Election ballot. Pursuant to D.C. Code, §1-1320(p)(2) (1992 Repl. Vol.), the Board hereby publishes the initiative as follows:

INITIATIVE MEASURE No. 51

SHORT TITLE

"The Real Property Assessment and Tax Amendments Act"

SUMMARY STATEMENT This initiative changes the real property assessment law to:

- Allow any taxpayer to challenge tax assessments on the public's behalf, or to intervene in assessment appeals before the Board of Real Property Assessments and Appeals.
- Require that all proceedings of the Board be held in public and that all information presented to the Board be publicly available.
- Establish a "Public Advocate" to represent the public interest before the Board and the courts on matters including but not limited to property asser nts; to conduct investigations; to appeal any assessments; and to advise the public of its rights under the tax laws.

LEGISLATIVE TEXT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUM-BIA, that this act may be cited as "The Real Property Assessment and Tax Amendments Act."

Section 2. The District of Cohimbia Real Property Tax Revision Act of 1974, as amended, (88 Stat. 1051; D.C. Code, §§47-801 et seq.) is amended as follows:

(a) Insert at the end of section 426a(d):

All meetings of the Board, including hourings of individual appeals of Class 5 property assessments, shall be open to the public, and the public shall not be excluded in any way from hearings on these individuals appeals. All information presented at Board meetings, including individual appeals of Class 5 property assessments, shall be available for public inspection.

(b) Insert at the end of section 426a(e):

in addition, any taxpayer may, on behalf of the general public of the District, appeal to the Board the assessment of any real property except Class 1 Property, Class 2 Property or Class 3 Property, or may intervene in any appeal brought by the owner of that property.

(c) Add a new section 426b which provides:

Sec. 426h Public Advocate for Assessments and Taxation

(a) There is hereby established an office of public advocate for assessments and taxation. The public advocate for assessments and taxation shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Council. The term of appointment shall be for five years. The public advocate shall not perform any service or work outside of this public office and shall appoint staff and additional personnel as may be provided for in the appropriated budget for the

- (b) The public advocate for assessments and taxation shall have the following powers and duties:
- (1) To appear before or to intervene in proceedings before the Board of Real Property Assessments and Appeals, the Superior Court and the Court of Appeals on behalf of the interest of the public and the taxpayers in general of the District and to demand a hearing pursuant to section 47-825.1(d) and/or (j) or under any other provision of law on any matter or proceeding in which the public advocate may down the public interest involved, including but not limited to proceedings with respect to:
 - (i) The valuation, assessment, or classification of any property, or
 - (ii) The appeal of an assessment of property and/or the tax pertaining thereto.
- (2) To make such investigations and employ such consultants or experts as the public advocate may deem necessary to the duties imposed herein.
- (3) To have full access to all government records necessary in carrying out the duties imposed herein.
- (4) To advise residents and taxpayers of the District generally of their rights under tax law.
- (5) To prepare and provide to the Council, the Mayor, and the public an annual report setting forth the activities of the office.
- (6) To exercise and perform such other functions and duties consistent with the purposes and provisions of this section which are deemed necessary or appropriate to protect the interest of the public of the District.

Section 3. Severability

If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity does nor affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.

Section 4. Effective Date

This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in §602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813: D.C. Code 61-233(c)(1).
