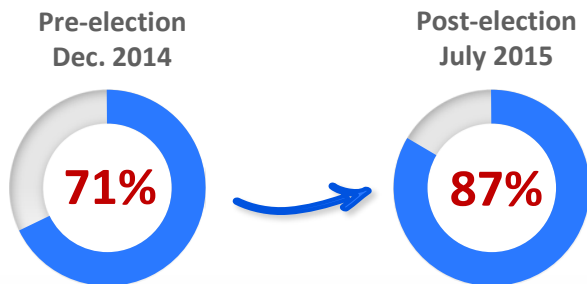




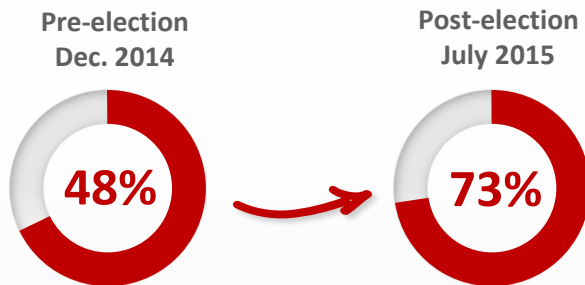
Knowledge and Perceptions of the Independent National Electoral Commission *Nigeria 2015 Post-Election Survey*

Public awareness of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) and INEC leadership increased significantly from pre- to post-election levels

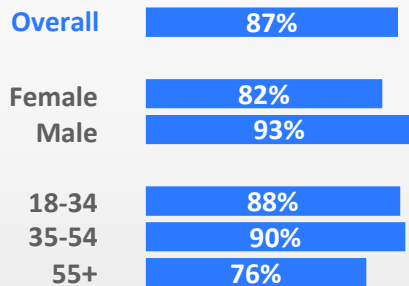
Public awareness of the INEC jumped by **16 percentage points** between pre-election and post-election levels



Public awareness of INEC Chairman Prof. Attahiru Jega increased substantially by **25 percentage points** between pre-election and post-election levels



While INEC enjoys high awareness levels across the board, **women are slightly less likely to be aware of INEC than men** and **Nigerians 55 or older are less aware of INEC than other age groups (-11 percentage points)**

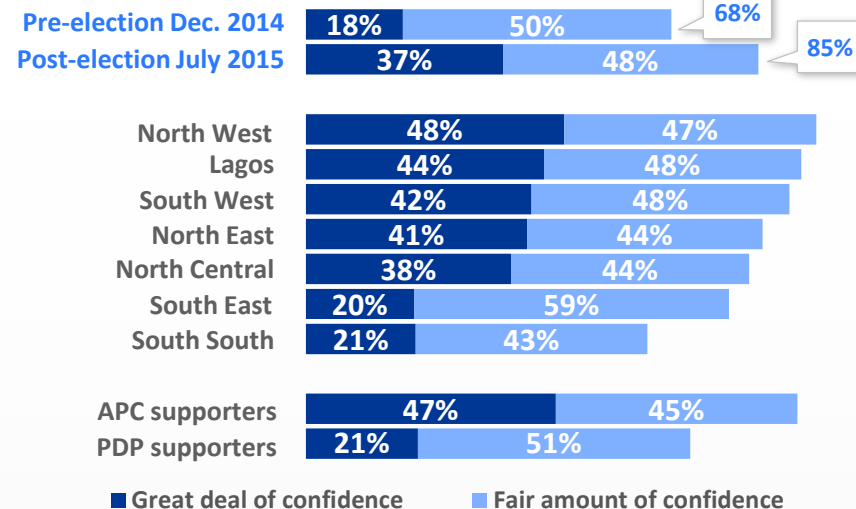


Public confidence in the INEC is high and increased dramatically from pre- to post-election levels

Confidence in the INEC up by **16 points** from pre- to post-election; Share of those with **“Great deal of confidence”** doubled;

South South/South East have lowest confidence in the INEC;

All Progressives Congress (APC) supporters have much more confidence in the INEC than **People’s Democratic Party (PDP)** (+20 points)



Awareness of the INEC website www.inecnigeria.org is low: it increased insignificantly between pre- and post-election levels
