

## Table of risk areas and red flags

Risk areas	Red flags
Donations/ loans	<ul> <li>Clusters/ patterns of donations/ loans (same family, donations made by people working for the same company, etc);</li> <li>Impermissible donors/ lenders (foreign/ anonymous donors, donations made in the name of another);</li> <li>Link between donors and participants in public tender(s);</li> <li>Unreported/ underestimated/ undeclared in-kind contributions or in-kind contribution disguised as volunteer activity</li> <li>Existence of online platforms to collect donations, such as Paypal, or donations by SMS where there are Insufficient regulations for online donations,</li> </ul>
Incumbents with previous cases of abuse of state resources	<ul> <li>Election campaigning in public institutions.</li> <li>Promising/ providing benefits to or requiring civil servants/ public employees to attend campaign rallies during working hours;</li> <li>Use of websites/portals of public institutions to promote an electoral contestant's campaign;</li> <li>Awarding or distribution of benefits to certain categories of the population (e.g. increases in salaries, pensions etc.)</li> <li>Recruitment, dismissal, transfer of duty of employees in public institutions except in specific circumstances.</li> </ul>
Vote buying	<ul> <li>History of vote buying in some constituencies;</li> <li>Complaints/ news articles on specific cases</li> </ul>
Digital spending	<ul> <li>Paid political advertisements on digital platforms do not clearly identify who has paid for them, i.e. lack of regulation regarding information/ imprint pertaining to the sponsor, owner or distributor of advertisements;</li> <li>Absence of/ absence of access to archives/Ad Libraries that contain all political advertisements, including the cost of each advertisement/ad run.</li> <li>Foreign interference through opposition/ support of a given party via administrators of accounts located abroad;</li> <li>Political finance oversight bodies' remit does not comprise online political advertising supervision.</li> </ul>
