Subject: Solicitation for Purchase and Delivery of Video Projectors in Cote d'Ivoire

The purpose of this Request for Quotes (RFQ) is to invite prospective suppliers to submit quotations for the purchase, delivery and installation of video projectors in Cote d'Ivoire. The RFQ provides suppliers with the relevant operational and performance requirements. Please note that this RFQ is being issued simultaneously in French.

When submitting quotations, vendors must respect all instructions, terms of reference, technical specifications, etc. contained in this RFQ. Non-responsive applications will not be considered.

#### **BACKGROUND**

IFES is an independent, non-governmental organization (NGO) with headquarters registered in the United States. IFES promotes democratic stability by providing technical assistance to the electoral cycle worldwide to enhance citizen participation and strengthen civil societies, governance and transparency.

# **DESCRIPTION OF GOODS/SERVICES**

The request for quotations is for the purchase, delivery and installation of 17 video projectors in Cote d'Ivoire.

## **Delivery:**

Delivery timelines provided must be door-to-door, from the point of origin to the Independent Electoral Commission (CEI), Abidjan, Cote d'Ivoire. In the presence of any local legal requirement to produce or deliver the products and/or services described in the Scope of work, the supplier will include the time needed to obtain possible, licenses, clearances and/or approvals in the timeline.

## FORM/CONTENT OF RESPONSE AND REQUIREMENTS

All quotations shall:

- 1. Be in the French or English language.
- Contain Annex A: Pricing Table, completed and submitted on the official letterhead of the vendor. Bidders must detail the make, model and specification of the proposed equipment in the pricing table.
- 3. Bidders must agree to guarantee the validity of the quoted price for a minimum of 90 calendar days. Prices should be quoted in Francs CFA for any vendor legally based in Cote d'Ivoire, and in U.S. Dollars (USD) for all other vendors.
- 4. Include evidence and guarantees for the requirements described below:
  - i. Demonstrated proof of the country from which the equipment is shipped
  - ii. Demonstrated proof of the nationality of the supplier
- 5. References: Contact information for no fewer than three relevant business references.
- 6. Include a contact name, email address, and telephone number to facilitate communication between IFES and the Bidder.
- 7. A brief outline of the company and services offered, including:
  - i. Full legal name and address of the company or individual;
  - ii. Full legal name of company's President and / or Chief Executive Officer;
  - iii. Year business was started or established
